



## Waimea Primary Care Medication Guidelines

- Waimea Primary Care and its providers **will not refill any perscription narcotics or controlled substance medication early** under any circumstance.
- **All medication refills must be requested 72 hours in advance** giving time for clinic to pharmacy communication and prescription filling.
- Any perscription narcotics or controlled substances that need a dosage adjustment or perscription extension beyond the perscribed date will **require a in-person appointment** with your provider.
- Any perscription narcotics or controlled substances lost, stolen, destroyed or contaminated will not be replaced early. It is the responsibility of the patient to keep their medications safe and taken in the proper dosages as perscribed according to instructions.
- Patients with long-term pain management needs will be referred out to a pain management specialist who will be responsible for the patients regiment and perscribing of controlled substances.
- Waimea Primary Care and its providers will not perscribe Benzodiazepines (Xanax, Halcion, Valium, Clonazepam, etc).
- If you are identified as shopping any perscription narcotics, controlled substances or flagged for substance abuse via HI-PDMP Waimea Primary Care and its providers reserve the right to discharge you as a patient.
- Any patient testing positive for methamphetamines will be discharged as a patient, unless they are in a certified drug treatment program and can provide the required paperwork.
- You have the right to obtain a paper copy of this notice from Waimea Primary Care, upon request, even if you have agreed to accept this notice electronically.
